

Customs Declaration Service: Make sure your export declarations are legally compliant

HMRC are aware that some export declarations are being submitted to the Customs Declaration Service (CDS) with key information missing.

Value DE 8/6 (Statistical value) is legally required for the majority of export declarations. Businesses must complete this value unless the <u>declaration completion</u> <u>instructions</u> state that this is not required.

Businesses must take care to provide all required information, otherwise declarations will not be classed as legally compliant, and may become liable to penalties.
